

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

JULY 16, 2018

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in workshop session in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall at 150 East Pearl at 3:34 P.M. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

MAYOR: Pete Muldoon.

COUNCIL: Don Frank and Bob Lenz. Jim Stanford joined at 3:39 p.m. Hailey Morton Levinson was absent.

STAFF: Larry Pardee, Audrey Cohen-Davis, Todd Smith, Johnny Ziem, Kelly Thompson, and Sandy Birdyshaw.

Police Utility Vehicle Purchase. Johnny Ziem and Todd Smith made staff comment on this replacement vehicle, reasons for it, and plans for the old vehicle. Jim Stanford joined the meeting.

A motion was made by Don Frank and seconded by Jim Stanford to approve the purchase of a new ATV style vehicle for the Police Department that will replace the existing all electric GEM vehicle being used for parking enforcement. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Town Electric Bicycle Program. Johnny Ziem made staff comment on the proposal of providing bicycles equipped to carry cargo for employee use while on Town business.

A motion was made by Don Frank and seconded by Bob Lenz to approve the purchase of six electric-assist cargo bicycles to be used for conducting Town business, at a cost not to exceed \$12,000 total. Mayor Muldoon called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

Adjourn. A motion was made by Don Frank and seconded Don Frank to adjourn to executive session to discuss the selection of a site or the purchase of real estate when the publicity regarding the consideration would cause a likelihood of an increase in price in accordance with Wyoming Statute 16-4-405(a)(vii), to discuss potential litigation in accordance with Wyoming Statute 16-4-405(a)(iii), and to discuss personnel matters in accordance with Wyoming Statute 16-4-405(a)(ii). The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 4:02 P.M.
