## This permit will be considered subject to the following terms and conditions:

The permittee shall make door-to-door notifications to the surrounding residents notifying them of the event and its hours of operation prior to the event.

On the day of the event, the permittee shall contact the law enforcement dispatch center at 733-2331 to notify them that the event will be commencing and provide them with a contact telephone number.

This permit shall be made available for inspection to any law enforcement officer upon request.

The person to whom this permit is issued is expected to monitor the noise levels of the event to ensure that it is conducted in a manner that reduces the likelihood that it will disturb the residents of the surrounding area or neighborhood. Additionally, all reasonable measures, such as keeping doors and windows closed, shall be made to minimize the likelihood that complaints will occur.

If complaints from residents are received, the person to whom this permit is issued shall be responsible for taking reasonable steps to see that the noise is abated in a timely manner. Failure to do so can result in the permit being cancelled by the responding law enforcement officer(s) and/or potential for the issuance of a criminal citation for violation of Municipal Code 9.44.010 when applicable.
