## SUMMARY OF USE OF FORCE INCIDENT BY THE JACKSON POLICE DEPARTMENT

### REASON FOR CONTACT AND FORCE USED

On January 2, 2022 at 0030 hours JPD officers responded to Town Square area to assist another officer who called out a fight between multiple people.

The last officer arrived on scene and began assessing where he was needed when he observed another officer attempting to calm a male subject who was standing in the middle of N. Cache. The officer took a cover position next to the male subject. The subject was significantly larger than both officers. The subject was exhibiting multipole cues of aggression including advancing on the other officer, leaning in toward his face while yelling, hiding his hands, exhibited a red, angry face, and was repeating non-sensical verbal justification of his action. The officer took the subject's left arm and starting escorting further away from his own group and the contact officer for safety. The officer moved and commanded the subject about half-way to his intended location when the subject began to lean back and started to mildly resist. The officer started to push the subject toward a snowbank and down at the same time so the subject would sit on the snowbank. The subject lost his footing due to the snow and ice and his intoxication and fell over backwards. While on the ground the subject was handcuffed without further incident. The subject was arrested for an outstanding warrant.

Soft-hand techniques: Physical restraint and control holds to include ground and/or fixed surface stabilization.

Hard-hand techniques: Strikes, kicks, and throws.

Chemical agents: OC Spray or CS Gas.

Impact tools: Straight stick or expandable baton.

Improvised tools: Any object used in a sudden defensive encounter (flashlight, ticket book, etc.)

Less-lethal impact munitions: Drag stabilized bean bag rounds.

Conducted Energy Weapon: Taser

Knives: Deadly Force Option

Firearms: Deadly Force Option

Vehicles: Deadly Force Option
