## SUMMARY OF USE OF FORCE INCIDENT BY THE JACKSON POLICE DEPARTMENT

### REASON FOR CONTACT AND FORCE USED

---

On 1/18/2022 at 0110 hours JPD officers were dispatched to a local hotel to investigate a disturbance. As a result of that investigation a male subject was arrested and charged with destruction of property and interference with a peace officer, attempting to cause bodily injury.

Officers arrested the male subject for destruction of property. While securing him for transport to the detention center officers were conducting a search of the subject's person. During the search the subject began to physically resist to the point where officers put the subject into a shoulder lock on both shoulders. While maneuvering the shoulder lock officers were asking the subject to stop resisting. The subject did not comply and head-butted the sergeant. The subject used a deliberate downward thrashing movement with his head to strike the JPD sergeant on the head. After the head butt the subject moved to head butt the sergeant again. The sergeant delivered a closed hand strike to the subject's rib cage to stop the second attack. The other officer grabbed the subject's hair and stabilized his head against the top of the patrol vehicle to prevent additional attacks. The subject was eventually placed in the patrol vehicle and taken to the detention center.

Injury to male: BLACK EYE, BRUISING

Injury to officers: MILD CONCUSSION

Soft-hand techniques: Physical restraint and control holds to include ground and/or fixed surface stabilization.

Hard-hand techniques: Strikes, kicks, and throws.

Chemical agents: OC Spray or CS Gas.

Impact tools: Straight stick or expandable baton.

Improvised tools: Any object used in a sudden defensive encounter (flashlight, ticket book, etc.)

Less-lethal impact munitions: Drag stabilized bean bag rounds.

Conducted Energy Weapon: Taser

Knives: Deadly Force Option

Firearms: Deadly Force Option

Vehicles: Deadly Force Option
