REASON FOR CONTACT AND FORCE USED

On 07/27/2022 at approximately 22:23 hours, a 34-year-old California male was arrested for public intoxication. Officers were called to investigate a highly intoxicated male in a parking lot. Officers responded, and found that the man was intoxicated to a degree that he was emotionally unstable and unable to care for his own safety. The male submitted to PBT resulting in a .379% BrAC.

During the arrest the male resisted being handcuffed and was taken to the ground. As he was taken to the ground, he sustained a laceration above his left eye.

Injury to male: Approximately 1 inch laceration above left eye.

Injury to officers: NONE

***LEGEND**

Soft-hand techniques: Physical restraint and control holds to include ground and/or fixed surface stabilization.

Hard-hand techniques: Strikes, kicks, and throws.

Chemical agents: OC Spray or CS Gas.

Impact tools: Straight stick or expandable baton.

Improvised tools: Any object used in a sudden defensive encounter (flashlight, ticket book, etc.)

Less-lethal impact munitions: Drag stabilized bean bag rounds.

Conducted Energy Weapon: Taser

Knives: Deadly Force Option

Firearms: Deadly Force Option

Vehicles: Deadly Force Option
