REASON FOR CONTACT AND FORCE USED

Law enforcement was dispatched to a local hotel for a fight in progress. Upon arrival the male party presented with a high level of agitation and threatening behavior. A female was present within the hotel room who appeared to be attempting to hide from the man. Entry was forced into the room by officers and the man was detained. His behavior indicated he was possibly experiencing medical issues and he was taken to the hospital. Controlled substances were also found in the room.

During attempts to subdue the male he resisted being handcuffed and was taken to the ground. While on the ground he continued to violently fight with the officers and a Taser was deployed.

Soft-hand techniques: Physical restraint and control holds to include ground and/or fixed surface stabilization.

Hard-hand techniques: Strikes, kicks, and throws.

Chemical agents: OC Spray or CS Gas.

Impact tools: Straight stick or expandable baton.

Improvised tools: Any object used in a sudden defensive encounter (flashlight, ticket book, etc.)

Less-lethal impact munitions: Drag stabilized bean bag rounds.

Conducted Energy Weapon: Taser

Knives: Deadly Force Option

Firearms: Deadly Force Option

Vehicles: Deadly Force Option
