SUMMARY OF USE OF FORCE INCIDENT BY THE JACKSON POLICE DEPARTMENT

REASON FOR CONTACT AND FORCE USED

On 12/20/2022 at approximately 2317 hours, Officers responded to local apartments for a verbal domestic between a woman and her intoxicated boyfriend. During their response, officers were notified of the domestic becoming physical and the 29-year-old Jackson female victim possessed a knife for self-defense. Officers arrived and investigated leading to the arrest of the 28-year-old Colorado male for unlawful contact. At the jail, the male submitted to a PBT resulting in .209%.

The male was secured in the back seat of marked patrol vehicle awaiting transport when he intentionally head-butted the transport cage.

Injury to male: Approximate 1.25" laceration to the center of his forehead.

Injury to officers: NONE

*LEGEND

Soft-hand techniques: Physical restraint and control holds to include ground and/or fixed surface stabilization.

Hard-hand techniques: Strikes, kicks, and throws.

Chemical agents: OC Spray or CS Gas.

Impact tools: Straight stick or expandable baton.

Improvised tools: Any object used in a sudden defensive encounter (flashlight, ticket book, etc.)

Less-lethal impact munitions: Drag stabilized bean bag rounds.

Conducted Energy Weapon: Taser

Knives: Deadly Force Option

Firearms: Deadly Force Option

Vehicles: Deadly Force Option
