REASON FOR CONTACT AND FORCE USED

Officers responded to a 58-year-old male subject who advised that he had tried to commit suicide by taking pills. The male was a resident of Teton County. The subject was contacted and transported to the hospital on a mental health hold for medical care.

During handcuffing the male began pulling away and tensing up, resisting being handcuffed. The male was put on the ground for stabilization for handcuffing.

*LEGEND

Soft-hand techniques: Physical restraint and control holds to include ground and/or fixed surface stabilization.

Hard-hand techniques: Strikes, kicks, and throws.

Chemical agents: OC Spray or CS Gas.

Impact tools: Straight stick or expandable baton.

Improvised tools: Any object used in a sudden defensive encounter (flashlight, ticket book, etc.)

Less-lethal impact munitions: Drag stabilized bean bag rounds.

Conducted Energy Weapon: Taser

Knives: Deadly Force Option

Firearms: Deadly Force Option

Vehicles: Deadly Force Option
