SUMMARY OF USE OF FORCE INCIDENT BY THE JACKSON POLICE DEPARTMENT

REASON FOR CONTACT AND FORCE USED

On 1/28/23 at approximately 2020 hours, a 46-year-old male, Jackson, WY resident was arrested for felony Interference with a peace officer, breach of peace, and pedestrian under the influence of alcohol. Officers were dispatched to a local bar for a disturbance involving the 46-year-old. When the first officer on scene contacted him on a local street near this establishment, the man led the officer on a short foot pursuit and engaged in fighting behavior with the officer. After a brief struggle, the man was placed under arrest without further incident.

During the termination of the foot pursuit the male went to the ground. As the officer tried to subdue the male, he attempted to kick the officer multiple times and grab at equipment on the officer's vest. The officer delivered one closed fist strike to the male's face, which ended the fight.

Injury to male: Bruising to the face (black eye). Approximate 1" laceration below eye.

Injury to officers: NONE

***LEGEND**

Soft-hand techniques: Physical restraint and control holds to include ground and/or fixed surface stabilization.

Hard-hand techniques: Strikes, kicks, and throws.

Chemical agents: OC Spray or CS Gas.

Impact tools: Straight stick or expandable baton.

Improvised tools: Any object used in a sudden defensive encounter (flashlight, ticket book, etc.)

Less-lethal impact munitions: Drag stabilized bean bag rounds.

Conducted Energy Weapon: Taser

Knives: Deadly Force Option

Firearms: Deadly Force Option

Vehicles: Deadly Force Option
